

Connecting Kids to GOVERNANCE

Your child or teen may qualify for free or low-cost health insurance coverage through Medicaid and the Child Health Plus Programs. Many parents may also be eligible.

If you or someone in your family needs health coverage, you should apply.

Medicaid and CHIP (Children's Health Insurance Program) typically cover a range of benefits including:

- Doctor Visits
- Emergency Care
- Hospital Care
- Immunizations
- Prescription Drugs
- Vision
- Hearing
- Dental
- Mental Health Services
